

Declaration of Copyright Protection

Licence to use Student EEICT competition Work

Faculty of Electrical Engineering and Communication, Brno University of Technology, residing at Technická 3058/10, 616 00 Brno (further referred to as FEEC), being the Student EEICT competition Organiser, has created a licence to handle the use of STUDENT EEICT competition papers.

By registering a paper in the STUDENT EEICT competition the Author or the Party authorised to license (the Employer) grants an exclusive Work licence to the Organiser for the entire period of copyright protection related to Work use. The Author is entitled to hold further Work rights:

1. Authors (or their Employers) can reproduce or authorise third parties to reproduce the whole Work or parts of the Work either for personal or Employer's purposes on condition that a FEEC and Student EEICT competition entitlement is cited and the Work is not intended for commercial purposes.
2. In case the above-mentioned conditions are not fulfilled, the FEEC shall be requested for granting such Work use permission.
3. The Authors (or their Employers) are entitled to use the whole Work or its parts in their other works. Nevertheless, they are not entitled to license third parties to do so. This right is reserved for the FEEC only.

The Author further declares to be the sole Author (or co-Author) of the original Work except for clearly cited parts (e.g. texts, figures, data, etc.) or for parts requiring an author's copyright consent.

The licence becomes extinct in case the Work is not published in the STUDENT EEICT proceedings or the Author requested no Work publication beforehand.

JOINT AUTHORS' RIGHTS

In case of co-authorship an authorised co-author grants the above-mentioned licence by registering the Work in the competition. Such co-author is then listed first in the Work, if consented by other co-authors.
